Due to its unique location and seclusion, Vis offers a distinctive charm and a glimpse into the Mediterranean as it once was, making it a fascinating destination to explore.

You'll spend the night in the town of Vis, located on the northern side of the island and developed around the ancient ruins of Issa, Croatia's first urban centre. History enthusiasts can visit the remains of a Roman thermal bath or the City Museum. Alternatively, enjoy a leisurely walk and admire the scenic "Villae Rusticae" along the coastline, adding to the picturesque landscape. Embrace the allure of Vis and soak in the serene ambiance of this historically rich island.

#### **Day 9: Vis - Korčula**

After a delightful breakfast, we set sail towards the enchanting island of Korčula, renowned as the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. Stroll through the narrow streets and marvel at the architectural wonders that have endured through the ages.

In the evening, explore the vibrant selection of konobas (taverns), restaurants, cocktail bars, and nightclubs both within and around the city walls. Your overnight stay will be at the port, allowing you to fully soak in the captivating atmosphere of Korčula and appreciate its rich history alongside its lively contemporary scene.

The cruise will then proceed to either Šipan, part of the Elaphite Islands near Dubrovnik, or Slano, located along the coastline. Both are charming fishing villages where we'll stay overnight. As the day ends, enjoy a delightful Captain's dinner onboard, savouring exquisite cuisine while surrounded by the enchanting beauty of the Adriatic seascape.

### FLIGHT INFORMATION

This package includes return flights from Melbourne or Sydney.

Flights from Brisbane, Adelaide and Hobart attract a \$400 surcharge and \$200 from Perth.

**Airline Selection:** We book the best available airlines for your journey, which may include a mix of full-service and low-cost carriers. Specific airline requests can be made at the time of purchase. This includes upgrades to your preferred carrier, premium economy or business class cabins or specific seats. Whilst we will try our best, not all requests can be confirmed.

**Flight Conditions:** Flights may not be direct and could involve a maximum of two transits.

**Ticketing Information:** Once issued, tickets are non-refundable. Changes are subject to airline rules, airline change fees, and an Asia Vacations Group change fee of \$250 per person.

**Passenger Details:** Please ensure all traveller names are as per passports. This includes all middle names. Errors may incur a name change fee of \$150 plus airline charges, or may require a forfeit of the existing ticket and purchase of a new ticket at an additional cost.

**Flight Schedule Changes:** Any changes or cancellations to airline schedules are outside our control. We recommend staying updated with airline schedules before departure. Additional expenses for extended transits or alternative arrangements are the traveller's responsibility.

**Internal Airfares:** Local flights included in your itinerary may utilise low-cost carriers without meals or

entertainment. Checked baggage is included; any additional baggage fees are payable at check-in.

**Booking Considerations:** If travelling with others on separate bookings, we may not be able to guarantee all flights are the same flight due to availability.

**Luggage and Fees:** You are responsible for your luggage at all times. Excess baggage fees, if incurred, are payable directly to the airline. All tickets will include 20 kg checked baggage per person, plus 7 kg of hand luggage. We recommend travelling with a max 20kg per person due to restrictions on internal flights (where applicable), as well as coach and train transportation. Please note, you will be responsible for handling your luggage at all times as the services of porters are not included.

**No-Show Policy:** Missing your flight may result in fees including a no-show fee, airline reissue fee, and possible new ticket purchase. AVG Travels charges a \$250 admin fee for re-booking assistance.

**Price Adjustments:** Prices are final at the time of ticketing. Any subsequent changes may result in additional costs due to factors beyond our control, such as currency fluctuations or airline surcharges.

AU Passport holders:

You do not need a visa for Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Albania if you are staying less than 90 days.

Travellers require a passport valid for at least 3 months after the traveller exits the country. You may be required to provide proof of minimum funds.

**IMPORTANT:** Visa requirements may change at any time without notice. You should contact the nearest high commission/embassy or consulate for the latest details.
