Day 2: - Arrive Barcelona, Spain

Welcome to Barcelona!

On arrival into Josep Tarradellas Barcelona-El Prat Airport (BCN), upon entering into the arrivals hall, you will be

met by a local representative and transferred to your accommodation.

Spend the remainder of the day at your leisure.

Please note: when booking international flights, please ensure that your arrival date into the starting city, falls on Day 1 of the itinerary.

Day 3: Barcelona

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before embarking on a captivating city tour of Barcelona. This half-day excursion offers a comfortable and informative way to explore the city's rich history and iconic landmarks. Begin with a guided walking tour through the narrow streets of the Gothic Quarter, the oldest part of Barcelona. Highlights include visits to Cathedral Square, the Cathedral itself, and the historic Jewish Quarter. Following the walking tour, board a bus for a panoramic drive through Barcelona. Pass by Montjuic Mountain, site of the 1992 Olympic Games, with views of the Olympic Stadium and an optional ride on the aerial tramway (weather permitting). Continue through Plaza España, the Venetian Towers, MNAC, and the former bullring transformed into the shopping center Las Arenas. Admire the elegant architecture along Passeig de Gràcia, home to Gaudi's renowned Casa Batlló and Casa Milà "La Pedrera." The tour concludes at Estació del Nord where the rest of the day and evening is at leisure to explore further on your own.

Day 4: Barcelona - Madrid

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before transferring to Barcelona's "Sants" train station to board a high-speed train bound for Madrid. Upon arrival in Madrid, you'll be transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is yours to unwind and explore at your leisure, allowing you to settle in and perhaps start discovering the vibrant Spanish capital at your own pace.

Next, enjoy a cruise along the scenic Douro River offering a unique perspective of Porto's historic waterfront and iconic bridges. Dive deeper into the city's cultural heritage with a visit to a renowned Port Wine Cellar, where you'll have the opportunity to taste this iconic Portuguese wine.

The remainder of the day is yours to explore at your own pace—wander through charming neighborhoods, sample local cuisine, or simply relax and soak in the vibrant atmosphere of Porto, a city brimming with history, culture, and culinary delights.

Afterwards, continue your journey to Fatima, a significant center of Christian faith and a global pilgrimage site. Visit the impressive Basilica and the sacred Cova da Iria, where the Virgin Mary reportedly appeared. Explore the Chapel of the Apparitions, the sanctuary's focal point housing the tombs of the three shepherds: Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta. As night falls, you may have the opportunity to witness the solemn candlelight procession, adding a spiritual and unforgettable dimension to your experience in Fatima.

Accommodation: Hotel Sao Jose Fatima 4* or similar

Day 8: Fatima - Batalha - Nazare - Alcobaca - Lison

Start your day with breakfast at the hotel. Depart for the Batalha Monastery, celebrated for its stunning Gothic and Manueline architecture and recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Journey onward to the charming fishing village of Nazaré, where you'll have free time to explore its picturesque streets and coastal views. Continue your journey to Alcobaca, another UNESCO World Heritage site, where you'll visit the 12th-century church and marvel at the tombs of Pedro and Inês de Castro. Finally, arrive in Lisbon and check into your accommodation.

Tonight, you can join an optional night tour to experience a traditional Fado show, a quintessential Portuguese music genre known for its emotional melodies and heartfelt lyrics (available to purchase on tour).

Day 9: Lisbon

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before embarking on a morning sightseeing tour of historic Porto. Traverse its main squares and avenues, passing iconic landmarks such as Belem Tower, Jeronimos Monastery, the Coach Museum, Monument to the Discoverers, Marquis of Pombal Square, and Liberty Avenue. The afternoon is yours to explore at leisure, allowing you to discover the charming corners of Alfama Quarter. This ancient neighborhood, nestled next to its Castle, boasts narrow, winding streets adorned with colorful buildings and authentic "tabernas" where the soulful melodies of Fado echo through the air, evoking a bygone era. Retire for the night at your hotel, reflecting on the day's discoveries in Lisbon, a city steeped in history and culture.

Day 10: Lisbon - Caceres, Spain - Cordoba

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before embarking on your journey early this morning to Caceres, celebrated as a UNESCO World Heritage site for its remarkable fusion of Roman, Islamic, Northern Gothic, and Italian Renaissance architectural styles. Wander through its picturesque Plaza Mayor and meander through the enchanting Old Town, where the Medieval Quarter showcases narrow cobblestone streets and well-preserved historic buildings. After soaking in the charm of Caceres, we continue towards Cordoba, a city steeped in history as the former capital of the Caliphate. On arrival, check in and the rest of the day is at leisure.

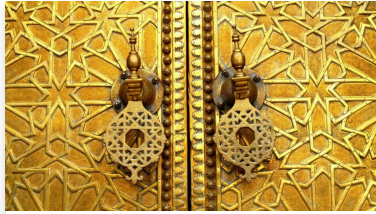

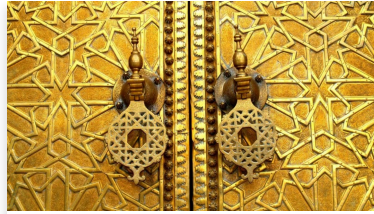
